Glasgow Herald Building, 11 Mitchell Lane 1894

Windyhill, Kilmacolm, Renfrewshire (47 km fr Glasgow) 1900

Glasgow School of Art 167 Renfrew St. 1897-99 & 1907-09

Hill house, Helensburgh (32 km northwest of Glasgow) 1902-03

Scotland Street School, 225 Scotland St. 1903-06

Willow Tea Rooms, 217 Sauchiehall St. 1902-04

Mackintosh House, 6 Florentine Terrace [now 78 Southpark Ave]

- Victorian end-of-row townhouse renovated by Mackintoshes 1906

GLOSSARY

aggregate

materials such as sand, gravel, or small stones – most commonly added to cement and water to make concrete and stucco

harling

term used in parts of Scotland for roughcast stucco (stucco containing aggregate resulting in a rough texture)

Gesamtkunstwerk

German word translated as "total work of art" applied in architecture when the architect designs the interior including most or all of the furniture and fixtures

gesso

plaster-based medium Margaret Macdonald Mackintosh used to make decorative panels for furniture & interiors
